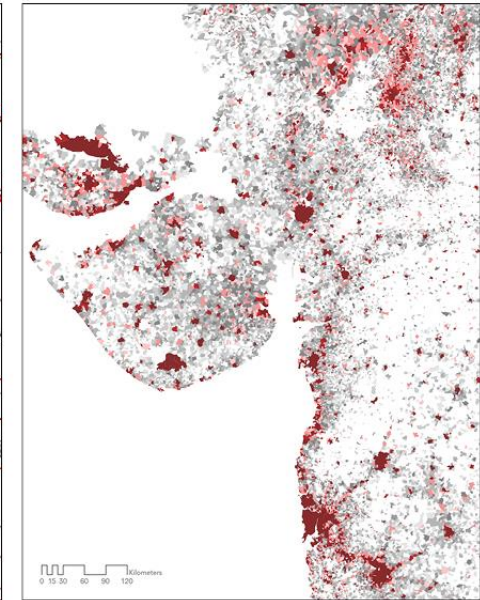
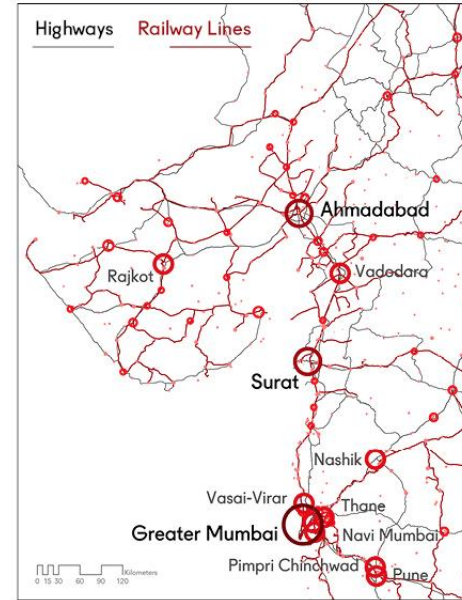
Corridors of shifting livelihoods within the urban-agrarian field



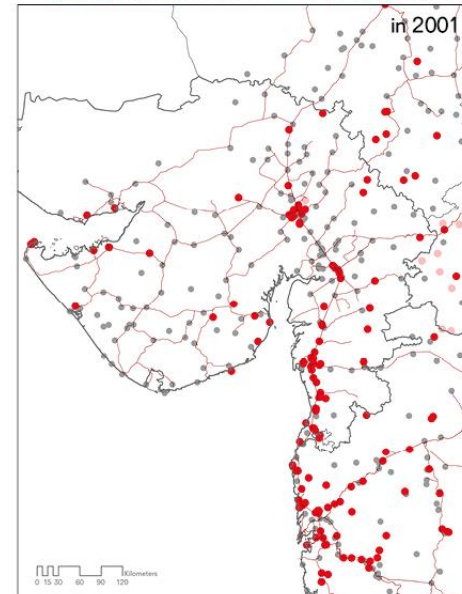
Areas experiencing growth between 1992 - 2013 (Based on difference in lights) overlaid on Population field (Settlements with density greater than 400 persons / km²)

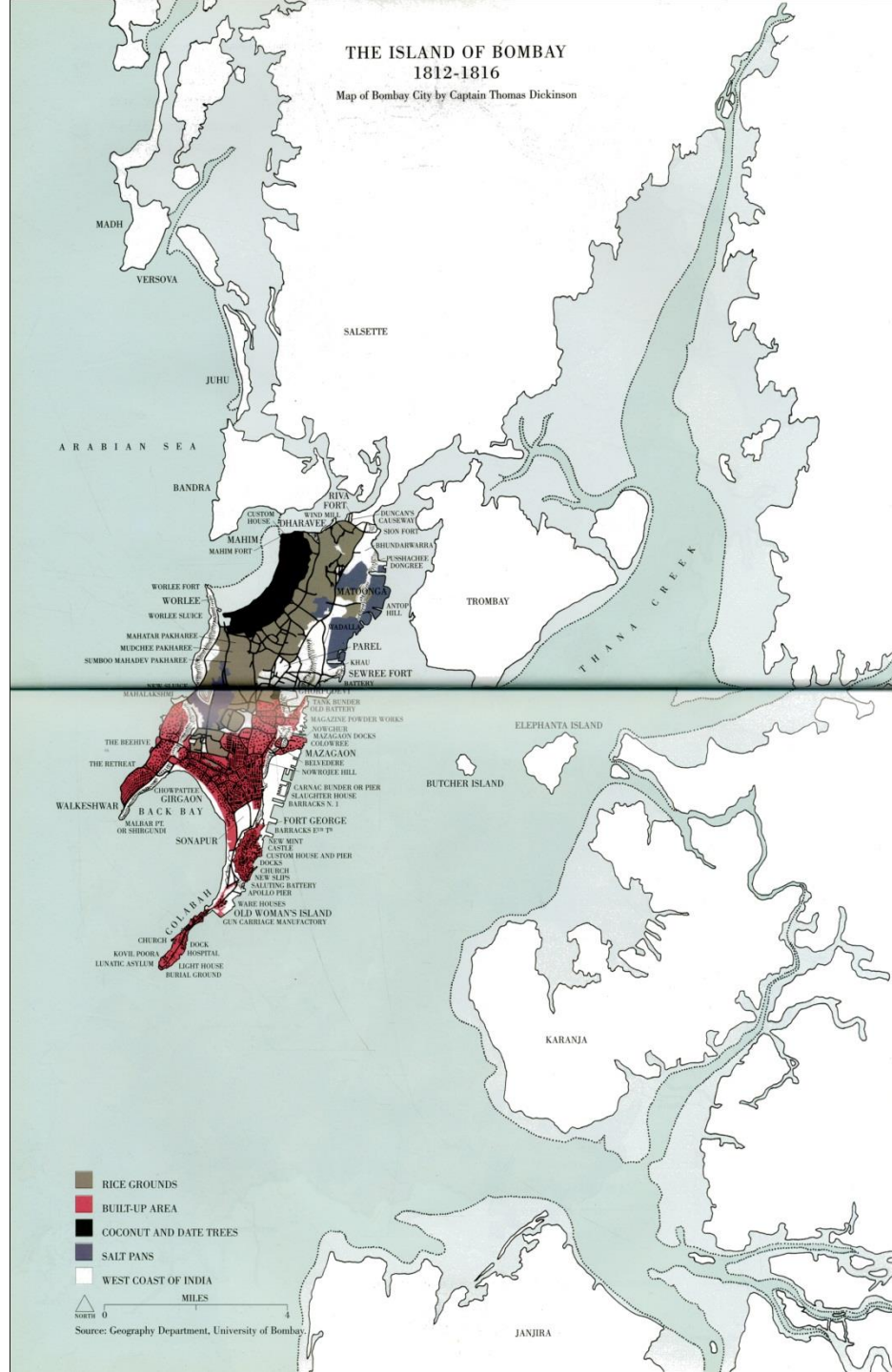

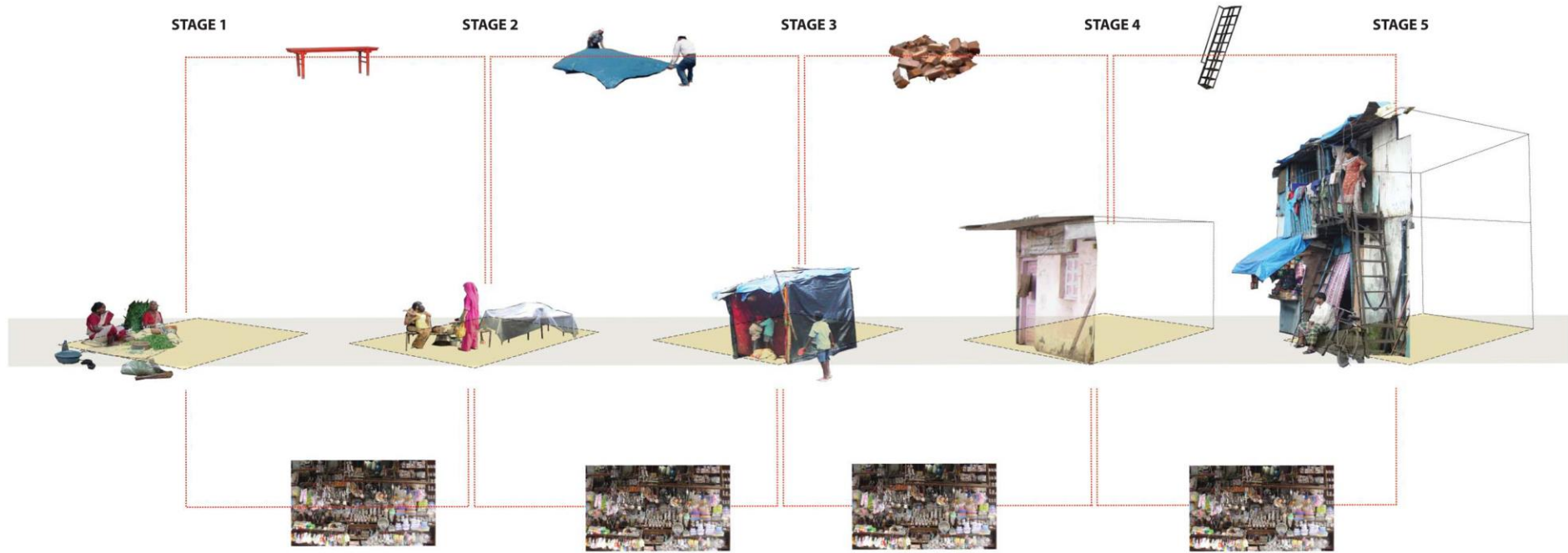

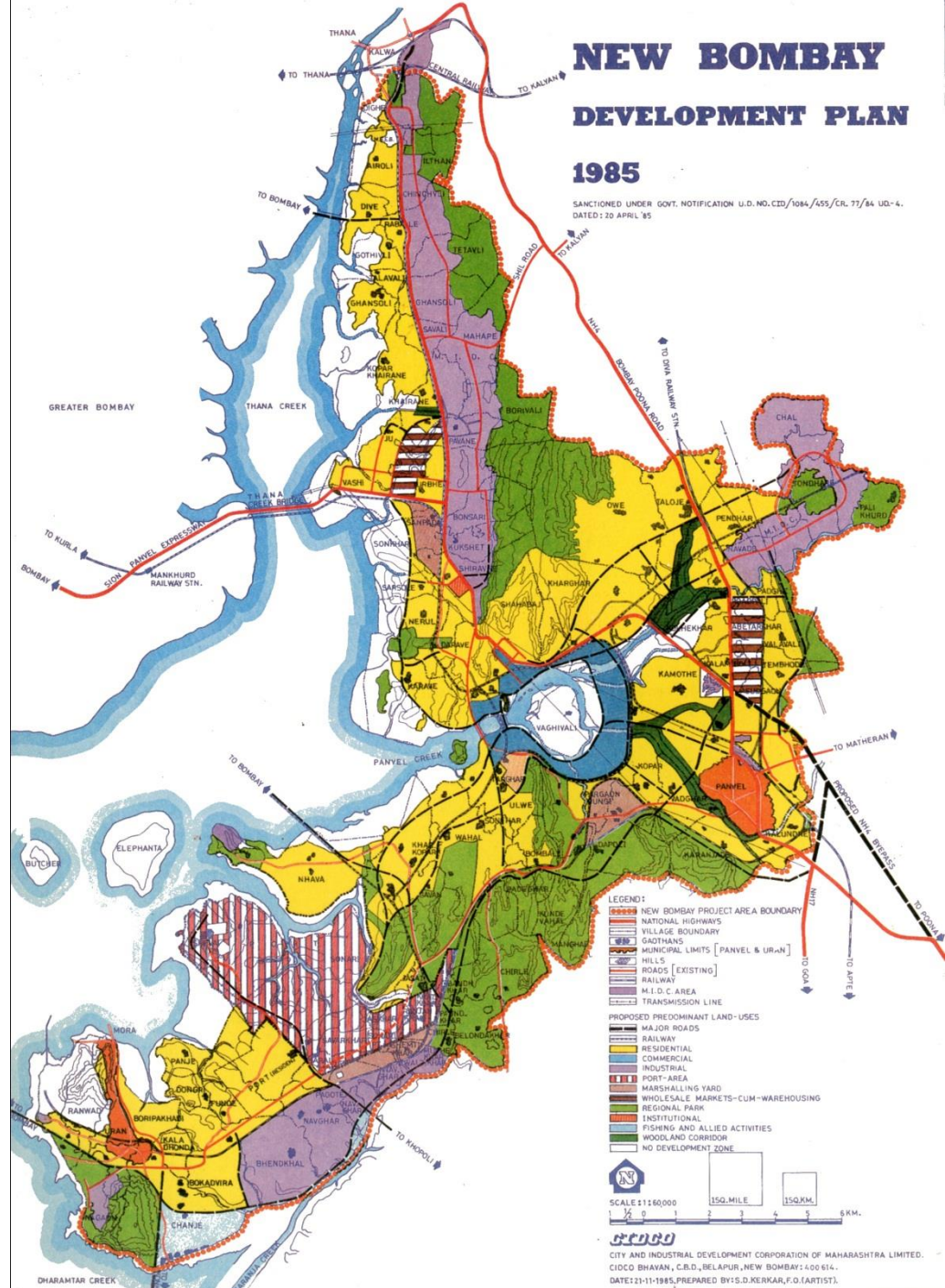
